Statement #1

The proposed use of funds is to replace the existing stadium turf at DPHS with a synthetic surface. In addition, the surrounding track will get resurfaced upon completion of the turf portion of the project. The synthetic surface be environmentally superior to the existing turf by not utilizing any water, pesticides or herbicides, while at the same time be able to be used effectively 24/7, as turf conditions are will not be weather or condition dependent. Scope of work to include: design, engineering, demolition and removal of existing field/turf and then construction of new drainage, and installation of synthetic turf field and resurfacing of the track.

Statement #2

Current budget for the new synthetic field is:

Demolition - \$75,750

Grading and Drainage - \$252,500

Artificial/Synthetic Turf - \$808,000

Track resurfacing - \$100,000

Statement #3

Approximately \$200,000 has been raised currently. The additional \$425,000 will be raised through a variety of methods of public outreach and requests to corporate and charitable foundations for grants.

Statement #4

In addition to the approximate \$200,000 that has been already raised for the installation of the new synthetic surface, Charger Associates has raised over \$70,000 each of the last two school years to benefit the athletic department at DPHS.
