To Extend Workers' Compensation Benefits to Unpaid volunteers

Whereas, the Board of Education of the Santa Barbara Unified School District wishes to formally recognize and encourage volunteer services. The parents, students and other members of the community have expressed an interest in voluntarily contributing their time and talents to furthering the cause of education in this district.

Whereas, the Board of Education recognizes that the risk of work-related injury or illness is substantially the same for volunteer workers as for paid employees of the district.

Whereas, section 3363.5 et. Seq. of the Labor Code of the State of California authorizes public educational entities to pass a resolution covering volunteer workers for worker's compensation benefits.

Now, Therefore Be It Resolved, that the Board of Education of the Santa Barbara Unified School District hereby requests to extend Workers' Compensation benefits to unpaid volunteers.
