Purpose of the study (be specific about goals, planned analysis, and reporting):

The data will be used to produce descriptive statistics of all questions based on student, staff, and parent/guardian demographic subgroups as identified in the Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP) reporting requirements. The primary focus of the descriptive analysis will be sense of connectedness, sense of safety, and parent involvement items on the parent survey. In addition, all parent survey questions will be filtered to provide sties with comparative data across parent subgroups to inform LCAP and SPSA planning, including parents of English Learners and students with disabilities.

Analysis and reporting will be done via loading the data into the separate database for WestEd survey data only that was established last year, and is securely housed by the SBUSD Educational Technology Services department (ETS); reporting will be automated through the use of SQL Server Reporting Services (SSRS). No staff other than the ETS and Research staff identified in the Application will have access to individual level data. All SQL reporting will be done in the aggregate, access to the online reports (i.e. data tables with numbers and percentages) will be restricted to district and site leadership, and cells containing fewer than ten responses will be marked with an asterisk to maintain confidentiality for small sample sizes.
