

Adelante Charter Renewal – Preliminary Review

May 28, 2019

Overview

Adelante Charter School (ACS), formerly named César Estrada Chávez Dual Language Immersion Charter School, has been in existence for 20 years and this will be their fourth renewal since their inception. Staff have been engaged in a year-long conversation with Director David Bautista and members of the board for ACS in preparation for this charter renewal and an update on their facility use agreement.

Updates in this Renewal

We asked ACS to include their California Dashboard indicators and provide commentary about how they will improve their outcomes as measured by the Dashboard. As the state accountability system continues to evolve, we will play a greater role in providing oversight and accountability for all of our charter schools.

The version that is included with this board report is the latest version from ACS based on cycles of feedback between SBUSD and ACS. We are waiting on a few more updates to the fiscal and governance sections which we will forward to the Board before final approval on June 25, 2019.

Facility Use Agreement

The next iteration of the FUA will capture and document the facility master planning in support of ACS that involves the construction of a new pre-school facility at the Parma School site.

Timeline

Then one more cycle of review and edits to their document

June 25, 2019 – final review and approval of both their charter renewal and facility use agreement
