# Academic Achievement

- Annual Performance Review (2018 CASSPP)
- ELA Target- 14.9% of SWD will be at a 3 or above (SBUSD 11.11%)
- Math Target- 12.6% of SWD will be at a 3 or above (SBUSD 8.12%)
- 2019 CASSPP results: ELA growth in 8/9 elementary schools, Math growth in 7/9 Elementary Schools. Growth in secondary is mixed.
