- Addendum to Facility Use Agreement approved by Board on May 26, 2018
 - \$2.4 M Budget from Measure J for portable replacements at Adelante used to develop Parma
 - Franklin Children's Center (FCC) moves to Parma when complete
 - Adelante expands into old FCC building


Parma Site

Challenges

- Existing building not Field Act compliant
- Building and recreational area will use most of the available space
 - 35 sq. ft/student indoor space
 - 75 sq. ft./student outdoor space
- Very limited parking onsite
- Will be necessary for parents to park in neighborhood or Trader Joes
- \$2.4M will be insufficient to develop the project

Some of the options the Board could consider are:

- Terminate the addendum to the Facility Use Agreement, and leave both programs in their current locations.
- Reallocate the \$2,400,000 to new classroom buildings at Adelante, and leave the Child Development Program in its current location.
- Sell the Parma property and allocate the proceeds to the Measure J Bond program.
