




COVID in Santa Barbara County

Daily Case Rate of Unvaccinated vs Vaccinated in Santa Barbara County




COVID in Santa Barbara County

- Testing offered to known contacts and exposures






School 1

California School Rapid Testing Program

- Abbott BinaxNow antigen test cards that provide results in 15-30 minutes
- Robust training for school personnel to perform on-site testing
- Use of the CDPH K-12 Schools Antigen Testing Program's a) physician order for testing** and b) CLIA
- Waiver (that allows the school to perform the testing)
- Students and Staff will self-swab.



Vaccination Clinics

- Communicating with families about the importance of vaccination and sharing info about upcoming clinics
- Applied with California Department of Public Health for Pop-Up Clinics at Secondary Schools
