- Gifted and talented definition
- Grades 3-6
 - Washington magnet
 - Individual elementary school programs
- Grades 7-12
 - Honors classes
 - Math enrichment, compaction
 - AP, IB, Dual enrollment

Identification Processes

- Grades 2-6
 - All 2nd graders assessed
 - 3-5th graders assessments
 - 6th graders assessed for placement in grade 7
- Grades 7-12
 - Placement exam for grade 7
 - Enrollment is interest based- grades 8-12
 - Equal Opportunity Schools

Opportunity/Achievement

- Identification
 - Grades 3-6: 337 students identified as GATE eligible
- Enrollment- Honors, AP, IB, Dual Enrollment
 - Grades 7-8: 1,541
 - Grades 9-12: 4,168
