**Credential Candidate Partnership
Santa Barbara Unified School District and Westmont College
2017-2018**

This is a partnership agreement between the Santa Barbara Unified School District and Westmont College's Education Department that offers California teaching credentials to elementary and secondary candidates.

The purpose of the partnership agreement is to renew a formal working relationship between both parties and to set forth the conditions that govern the partnership. The goal is to provide linkage across the learning-to-teach continuum between credential candidates at Westmont and experienced teachers in Santa Barbara's Schools.

The Santa Barbara Unified School District and Westmont College Education Department agree to the following:

- 1) Collaborate to make K-12 classroom placements available for Westmont pre-professionals and credential candidates for 2017 - 2018.
- 2) Collaborate and communicate regularly with principals and cooperating teachers about pre-professional placements (and/or student teaching placements) and progress of Westmont students in the classroom.
- 3) Inform credential candidates of their responsibilities in the classroom.
- 4) Keep record of fieldwork hours and give feedback to the candidate, supervisor and during the placement period.
